Rules and Regulations

The EKAHA High Point Awards are for horse(s) involved in competition in various disciplines, entered in the program by club members. The award will be received based on the number of points achieved in the various disciplines outlined below.

1. To be eligible, each participant must be a member in good standing of the EKAHA Club.
2. Points will accumulate from December 1st through November 30th of the competition year.
3. Nominations may be submitted at any time during the season; however, points earned before nominations were submitted will only be counted for double the cost of entry.
4. Points must be turned in or postmarked by December 15th of the competition year.
5. When a multiple judging system is used, points may only be counted for the final placing in the class. If it is a double-show running simultaneous, points will be counted for each judge and each show separately.
6. Points earned by a youth rider must be designated for “youth” or “performance” and cannot be used for both.
7. There will be a Champion and Reserve Champion for each category.
8. An “Overall High Point Horse” will be awarded to the performance horse with the most points overall. All Distance or Endurance horses may be eligible for the “Serenata Cup.”
9. Official Specialty Classes:
 - Driving
 - Trail
 - Reining
 - Showmanship
 - Show Hack
 - Costume
 - Side Saddle
 - Leadline
